- > Must complete 60 units for associate's degree (AA/AS) & UC/CSU transfer

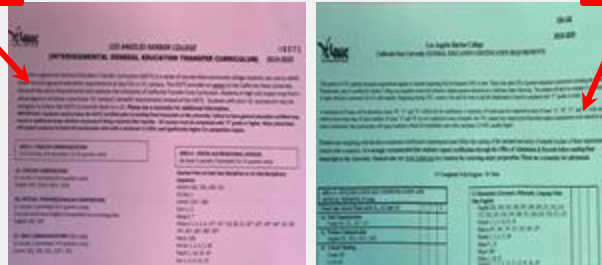

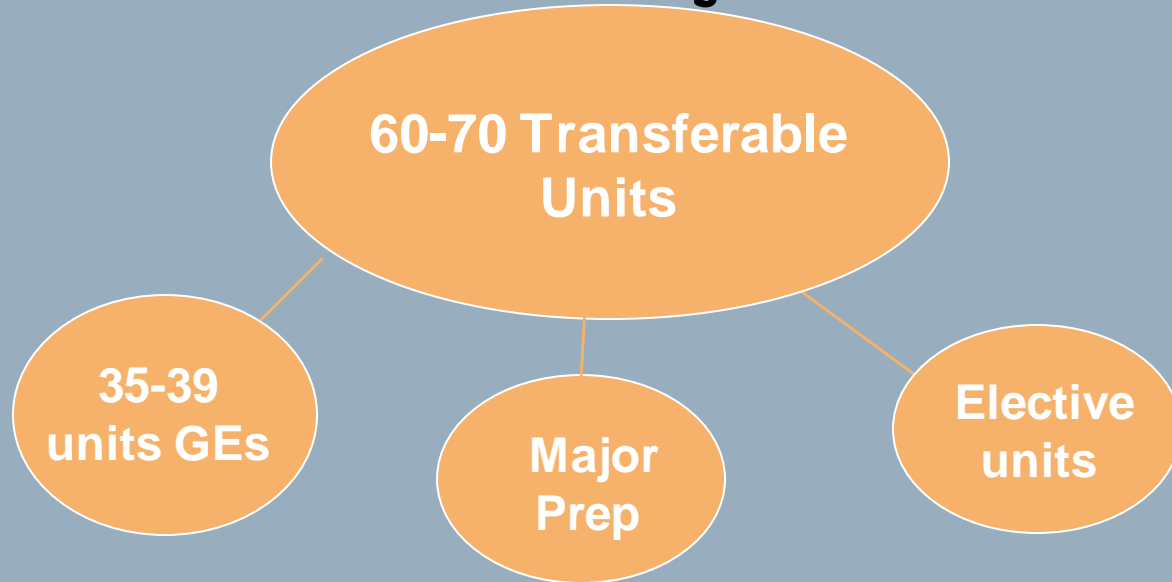
ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT) BENEFITS!

- > Guarantee admission to a CSU Campus
- > Receive a 0.1 GPA bump when applying to an impacted major outside your local area
- > Non-impacted major at an impacted campus will be awarded a .2 GPA bump for admissions decisions
- > Pair well with UC major prep for various pathways
- > Applicable to select Private Universities, Historically Black College University (HBCU) & out-of-state transfer
- > Some ADTs are a match to multiple majors at CSU
 - Ex: Spanish ADT at LAHC is a match to 4 different majors at CSULB

Transfer admission guarantee (TAG)

Six UC campuses offer the Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program for California community college students who meet specific requirements.

By participating in TAG, you may receive early review of your academic records, early admission notification and specific guidance about major preparation and general education coursework.

Keep in mind TAG applications are due Sept. 5, but you can only apply for a TAG at one campus. To keep your options open, apply to other UC campuses during the regular application cycle (Nov. 1-15).

The TAG website (TAG) provides a list of participating campuses and campus-specific requirements to qualify.

How to pursue TAG

1. Use the UC Transfer Admission Planner to complete the TAG application, and review it with your community college counselor and/or UC campus TAG adviser (only need to submit it Sept. 1-5 for the fall term (May 1-5 for the winter/spring term).
2. Fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements in your TAG agreement.
3. Fill out the application for admission to UC and submit it from 5-15.

Key dates and deadlines

May 1-5	Submit your TAG for winter/spring term.
Sept. 1-5	Submit your TAG for fall term.
Nov. 1-15	Submit your UC application for undergraduate admission.

California College Promise Grant (formerly named the BOG Fee waiver)

Form of enrollment fee assistance/Waives tuition

LA College Promise Grant

Free tuition for two years of college

Must be enrolled full-time & have no previous college coursework

Federal Pell Grant Program

Up to \$6,095

Maximum lifetime eligibility of 600% (12 full-time semesters)

Cal Grants - A/B/Transfer Entitlement/C

Up to \$1,672 for books and living expenses (Cal Grant B)

Eligibility limit of four-years of full-time grant payments

Could receive close to \$10,000 of aid*

*Based on completing FAFSA, eligibility and financial/academic requirements



WHAT IS A STUDENT EDUCATION PLAN (SEP)?

- > Sometimes called Ed Plan
- > List of courses divided by semester for a student to complete their goal
 - Transfer requirements (AA-T, AS-T)
 - Associate degree (Architecture, Culinary, Nursing)
 - Certificate of Achievement



STUDENT EDUCATIONAL PLAN EXAMPLE

Major: Business (AS-T)

English 101 (3),

Math 227 (4),

Comm 101 (3),

Business 1 (3),

Counsel 20 (3)

English, Math & Communication meet Golden 4 for CSU (required for transfer & degree), Business 1 is a requirement for the major. Counseling 20 meets CSU GE Area E & is Career Planning!

BENEFITS OF ENROLLING IN 15 TRANSFER UNITS EACH SEMESTER

- > Remain eligible for Harbor Promise
- > Stay on track for 2-year transfer
 - 15 transfer units (Fall) + 15 transfer units (Spring) = 30 units in 1st year
 - 30 (1st year) + 30 (2nd year) = 60 for transfer!
 - Transfer Tip: 30 unit completion with 3.0+ GPA = eligibility to apply for UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)
 - Apply for UC TAG Sept. 1 – 30 of 2nd year
 - Apply for UC Admission Nov. 1 - 30
 - Visit Transfer Center for more info

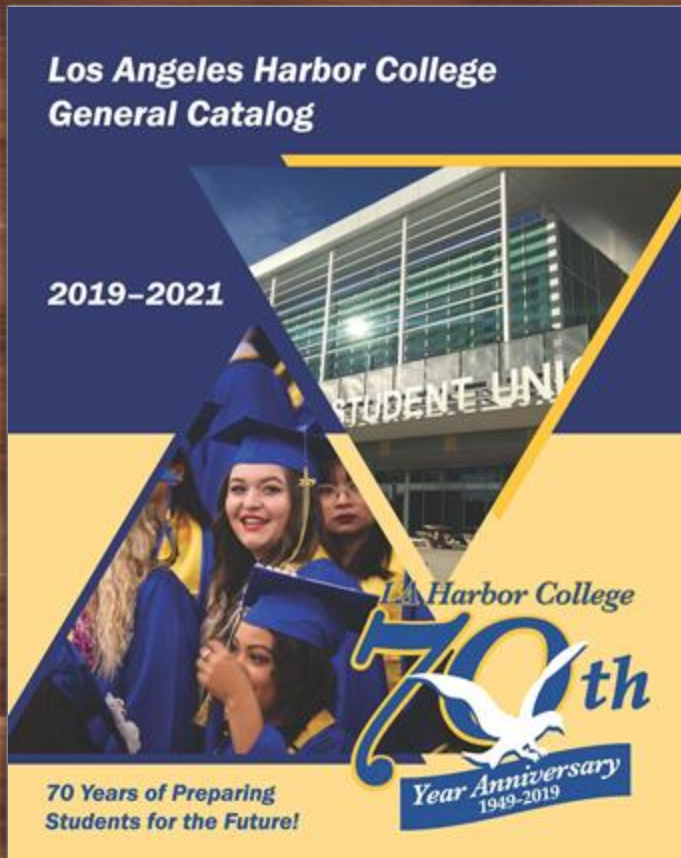
CAN I SIGN UP FOR CLASSES BEFORE MAKING AN ED PLAN?

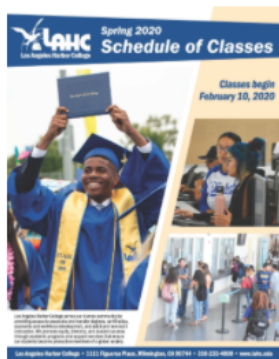

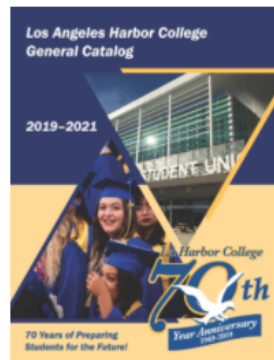

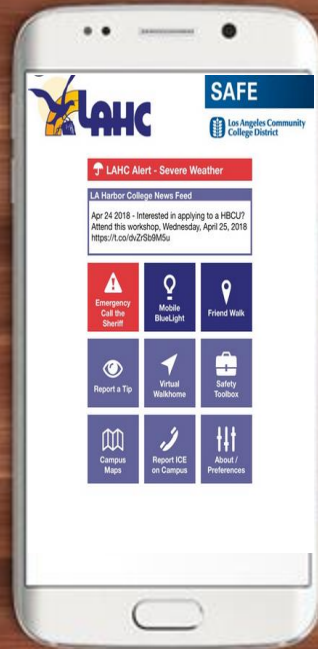
